But in who gets the older flattery in this version 2013 the group is the young New Yorker Camille Thurman, invited especially for cover the absence involuntary of Laura Andrea Leguía, saxophonist holder and composer of various melodies that form part of the repertoire of the band. Camille touches the sax and flute with a fluidity surprising, binds their complexes solos with the harmonies which proposes the trumpet of Gabriel. Addition, sings and does it very well. The night in the Jazz Zone, interpreted a classic version topic *Moon river* that made jump from excitement to their fellow group, with an unexpected section scat the style Ella Fitzgerald. According counted the group leader during the concert, the saxophonist never had touched Peruvian music before, but arrived at trial with whole repertoire learned from memory, making suggestions and innovations.
